

PREPARATION FOR GASTROSCOPY

Examination in the morning



1. On the day of the examination, stay on an empty stomach, without eating and drinking.
2. Before gastroscopy, there is usually no need to set aside anticoagulants, if you have any questions you can ask your doctor.
3. The purpose of the best endoscopic assessment at least 2 weeks before the planned examination is advisable to discontinue (if previously used) drugs such as proton pump inhibitors - unless the doctor recommends otherwise.
4. In the event that antibiotics were used before gastroscopy (does not apply to eye drops and skin ointments) it is also recommended to perform gastroscopy no earlier than a month after the end of treatment - unless the doctor recommends otherwise.
5. You should not bring valuable items or jewelry to the ambulatory, because staff are not responsible for their destruction or loss.
